Minimum Number of Members	50 members, including its Chair and Vice Chair. Chair serves on the Spine Health Board as an ex-officio member with vote and selects the Vice Chair.
Purpose	Drives Spine Health's patient education, research, and advocacy.
Duties and Responsibilities	Contributes to Spine-Talks content development, dissemination, and promotion. Advises on Spine Health's official policy and position statements. Fosters collaboration with individuals and organizations who share Spine Health's vision. Connects Spine Health with the most talented researchers and scientists in spinal health. Increases the funds available for patient education and advocacy and research. Reviews and selects research projects on spinal health prevention and patient care. Attends and supports the annual gala.
Skills Required	Be a recognized expert in spinal health. Knowledgeable about current research, patient care, and innovation in spinal health.
Time Required	2-4 hours per month. Three year commitment.
Reports to	National Spine Health Foundation Board of Directors who also select and invite the chairman of the Board and its members.
